## Basin Theology John 13:5-17; Matthew 27:24

Being a servant is not so much about the <u>act</u> you do as it is the <u>heart</u> you have

Jesus repeatedly declared His mission of service:

- "The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve"
- "Whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant"
- "The first among you shall be your slave"
- "Love your neighbor as yourself"

"Basin Theology" - illustrates the attitude of your heart

In less than twenty four hours two basins are mentioned in Scripture

Basin 1 Theology – "I am willing to serve you" John 13

- There is no act of service too small v5
  - Foot washing was one of the most humiliating tasks
- I am willing to do the <u>unexpected</u> v6
- I serve with no expectation of <u>return</u> v7
- I am willing to serve those who would wrong me v11
- There is no one too big to be a servant v13
- I want my service to be an example for others to follow

Basin 2 Theology – "I don't want to get involved" Matthew 27

- My efforts won't make any difference!
- It's more important to me what others think
- I am really not <u>responsible</u> for you
- I serve with no expectation of <u>return</u> v7
