III John is the shortest book in the Bible -219 words

Written to an individual, Gaius, in a church in Central Asia

- I, II, and III John address heresies and controversies in the 1st Century church in Central Asia
 - 1. Was Jesus the Christ?
 - 2. Was He really flesh and blood?
 - 3. Spiritual arrogance and superiority beginning of Gnosticism

 - o "The Elder" Apostle John. Reference to age and authority
 - o "Gaius" common name, a church leader in Asia Minor
- Love in truth
 - o Not merely lip service I John 3:18
 - Sincerely
 - o In action

True Prosperity is Initiated by the Desires of the Heart v2

- "Agape" love desires God's best for another
- "Prosper" a good journey in all respects
- Spiritual prosperity Ephesians 1:7; 3:8

True Prosperity is Characterized by the Practice of Truth v3

- Gaius' testimony he walks in truth
 - o Embrace the truth of God's Word
 - o <u>Live</u> the truth by practice
- A lifestyle of truth is your most powerful testimony
- A lifestyle of truth will be a source of joy for others
