The Circle of 1

"circle" - a round plane figure whose boundary (the circumference) consists of points equidistant from a fixed point (the center)

- The center of the circle is <u>you!</u>
 - Someone who has met Christ
 - Someone who cares about someone else
 - Someone who is willing
- The circle may be near to you
 - o Andrew found his brother Simon
 - Philip found his friend Nathaniel
 - o Is your "1" in your family, friends, associates?
- The circle may be far from you
 - o Philip goes to the Ethiopian eunuch
 - Different in every way from Philip
 - o God had prepared
 - Be attentive for God to lead others in your path that you don't know

The Call of 1

- An invitation
 - No one can ever force someone to come to Christ. All we can do is invite.
 - It is a statistical fact that most people who don't attend church would come if someone invited them. "82% are somewhat likely to attend if invited," Thom Rainer, "The Unchurched Next Door"
 - o "98% percent of church goers never extend an invitation in a given year," Thom Rainer, "The Unchurched Next Door"
 - "Our church is having a special back to church day on September 8. Our pastor is encouraging us to bring a friend. Would you guys like to come as my guest? Lunch at noon and games for the kids."
- An introduction
 - o They all invited someone to meet Jesus

The Consequence of 1 Invitation

- Peter became the Apostle to the Jews and one of the main pastors at the church in Jerusalem
- Nathaniel
 - o Don't know full extent, but Jesus said he was an example of true Israelites
- Ethiopian eunuch
 - o Royal official, highly educated
 - Missionary to Africa
